Water educational trail

The starting point for the Osterwick water educational trail is the "Pfarrhausgräfte"; a small ditch around the Parish House. This small ditch around the Parish House is a good example of how people in the Münsterland protected their homes and farms from unwelcome guests in earlier times, making use of the water. But there are many other examples of the importance of water for people and the environment. This is exactly what today's water trail aims to show. Exciting theme boards inform about:

Water as: Life insurance, marine habitat, pond, river and shore, hydropower and disasters, springs, water shortages and supplies.

But we want our little and big visitors to experience the water directly. Experimenters can use a pump well to feed a small dam, measure the water depth with a gauge and divert water with a scoop wheel. And you're sure to get your feet wet in the water treading pool.

Use of the shelter

The shelter was built in the style of an old agricultural wagon shed and has a large canopy for shelter and seating - for anyone who wants to come without registration. There is a disability-friendly restroom facility to the side, which can be used at any time at €0.50.

If you also want to sit inside and use the kitchenette, the large barn doors can be pushed aside and there is a lovely lounge with a panoramic view of the play area. Equipped with beer table sets, bar tables, refrigerator, porcelain and cutlery. Use is possible after prior registration at www.dorfpark-osterwick.de.

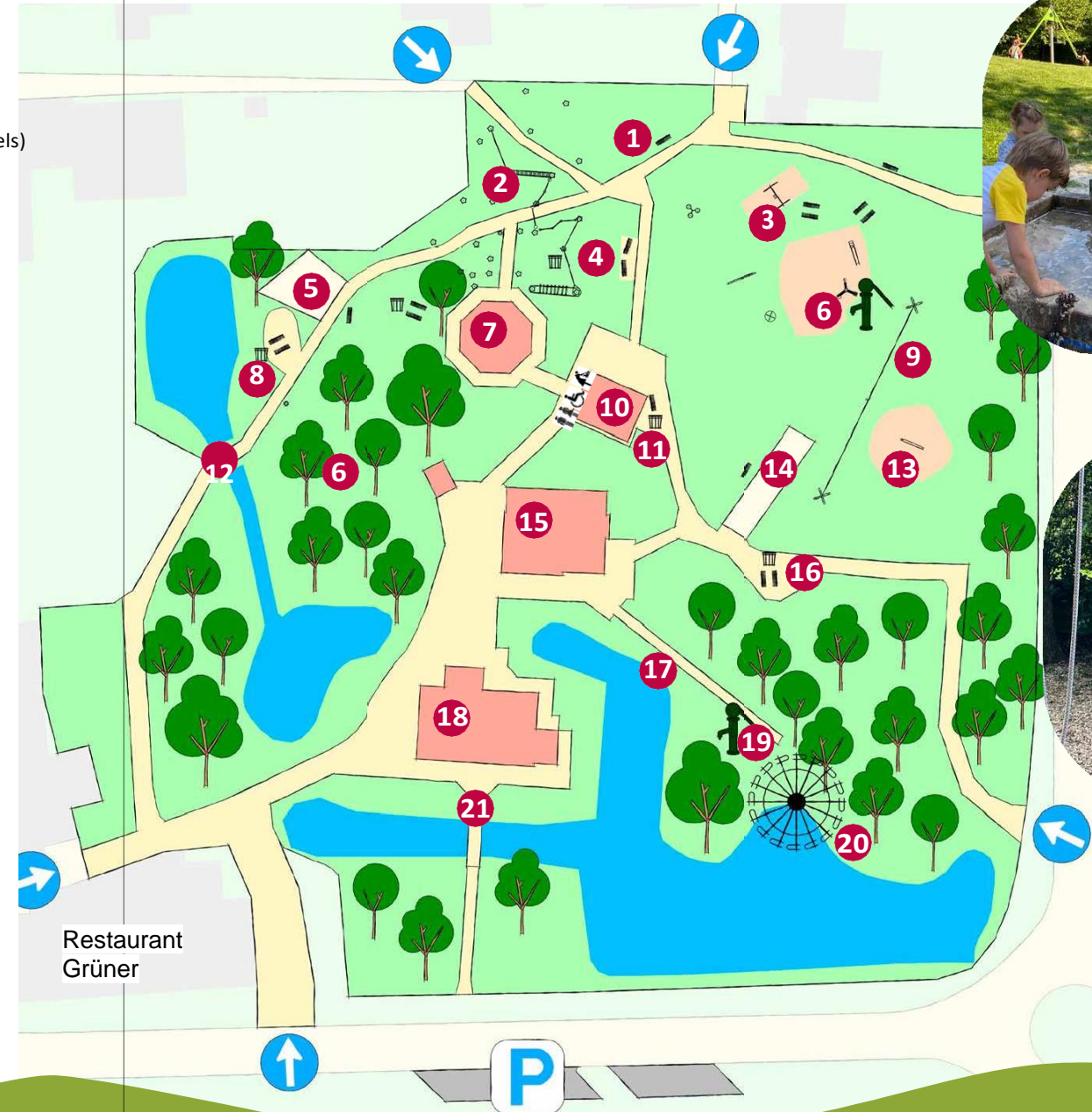


Games and sports

Aviary

The aviary in the Village Park Osterwick is almost a small bird Zoo. Here the birds have plenty of space and can fly far. Bird friend and expert Heinz Elfering has been looking after their well-being for more than 30 years. And to let you know exactly which bird species live here, information boards have been installed for the budgerigars, the zebra finches and all their chirping fellows.

Boule area

Actually, the correct name for the leisure variations of the leisure ball game "Pentanque", which is played in public places in France. Nevertheless, the playing field dimensions of a sports track with 16 m x 4 m are available, so that you can practice the sports or leisure game at any time without prior registration.
